- 3. **EM Fluids** -Three of EM Fluids units have been installed at the following locations: Lake He Ho Ha, Southview, and Silver Sands. Testing conducted for Phycocyanin (a blue-pigmented protein complex found in cyanobacteria (blue-green algae) and red algae.) and chlorophyll. Testing to continue until the end of August. Bernie's team focuses on Flowering Rush but take time (1 day/2weeks) to conduct this testing as past of their program. Creekwatch is testing Marigold Creek, Sturgeon River, and Trestle Creek. Results will be available once a final report is complete.
- 4. **Flowering Rush** Due to higher than usual water levels at the end of June in Lake Isle, the Flowering Rush could not be located. There are other areas to be monitored.
- 5. **Financials** Bank Balance as of June 31, 2025; \$18,197.01 with nothing outstanding.
